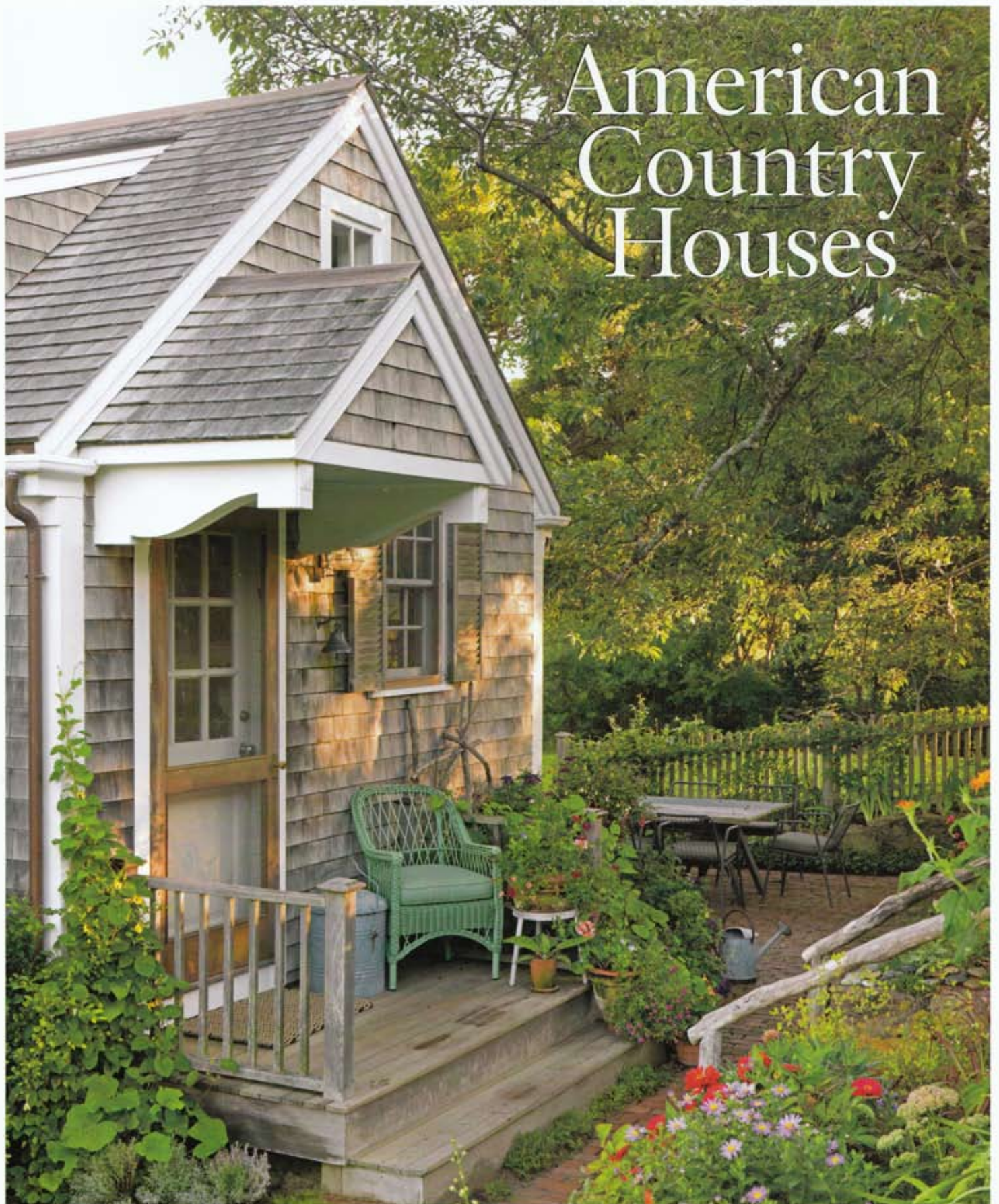

Los Angeles Art Show

The annual Los Angeles Art Show was held at the Barker Hangar at the Santa Monica Airport in late January. All proceeds from the Opening Night Gala benefitted the Art Museum Council and the Prints and Drawings Council of the Los Angeles County Museum of Art.

The exceptional fair, hosted by the **Fine Art Dealers Association (FADA)**, boasts an international roster of galleries exhibiting works for purchase from the 19th through the 21st centuries. This year's show had more than 125 dealers—the largest number of exhibitors in its history—and included IFPDA's Los Angeles Print Fair. The show doors were open to all for an admission fee of \$20.

Gallery participation is by invitation only, and all work displayed is vetted for authenticity by leading experts in the various fields of art. Vetting is made possible by sponsorship from FADA, and this commitment to excellence and quality makes the Show one of the finest art fairs in the country.

Throughout the run of the show, a series of presentations and lectures are offered. Topics include art appreciation, collecting, wine tasting—the 2008 event featured **Souverain Winemaker Ed Killian**—and more. Visit www.laartshow.com and www.fada.com.
