In addition to premier offerings in Modern and Contemporary art, this year's fair will feature The European Pavilion, with special curated exhibitions centered on the latest in the continent's Contemporary art movements. The fair will also showcase and recognize participating female-owned galleries. Ever concerned with philanthropy and outreach, organizers will donate 15% of this year's proceeds to the American Heart Association.

Running concurrently, DIVERSEartLA serves as the



fair's non-commercial platform and provides a collaborative space for dialogue and experimentation on a selected theme. Event curator Maria Caichielo's 2024 programming will focus on the inter-

sections of memory, humanity, and AI, and consider the ethical and socio-political implications of these new technologies.

Among this year's exhibitors, New York's Arcadia Contemporary will show work from Oslo-based painter Kesja Tabacruk. *Impossible to Resist*



(2022), an oil on canvas portrait of a young woman holding a large pink pum, is remarkably photo realistic in effect. Tokyo's Silver Shell Gallery will feature work from Choi Seung-Yoon, including work from his series *Cross Section of Stars*, which features dynamic, yet precisely controlled, strokes and masks in primary hues.

In the booth from London's Rebecca Hossack Art Gallery, visitors will be wowed by Madrid-based painter Nikolaeta Sekulovic's large scale portraits that explore the figure as well as pattern. *Vita Sackville West* (2023) is an imagined portrait of the notable English author, garden designer, and antique lover to Virginia Woolf. West rests easily in a riotous field of florals and patterning. Sekulovic hopes to show her subject "stripped of external expectations and in a state of authenticity."

For those looking for art that combines

ancient tradition with contemporary techniques, visit Santa Fe's Blue Rain Gallery and view work from Vivian Wang, including her *Mongolian Leopard*. The artist's intricate sculptures incorporate ancient Chinese techniques including stoneware and gold leaf, supplemented with the new in the form of cast glass. A former fashion designer, her work is also inspired by historical textiles.

London's Cynthia Corbett Gallery will feature Andy Burgess' reimaginings of modernist architecture, including *Quiet Courtyard* (2021). The artist reinvents and abstracts real places to create dreamlike and seductive spaces. His courtyards and pool scenes are especially fitting at this LA fair.

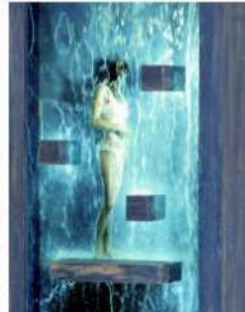
Black History Month played significant roles in this year's fair as well as key initiatives that support the next generation of artists from "Athletes for Life" founded by former NFLer Greg Bell to the featured exhibition of Young Masters Art Prize, presented by Cynthia Corbett Gallery, London, supporting emerging talents from diverse backgrounds.

LA Art Show's educational platform, DIVERSEartLA, partnered with seven international art institutions to explore the intersection of memory and AI. Projects included the Nevada Museum of Art that presented "The Journey" by Guillermo Bert, featuring 20 life-sized wood sculptures of immigrants employed as frontline workers during the pandemic as a way to explore how ancient traditions and AI merge to create narratives of identity and memory. AAL Museum (Santiago, Chile) presented a hypnotizing visual narrative, "Be Water," led by esteemed artist, Antuan, highlighting the essential collaboration between humanity and AI to create a new network of human consciousness.

A few other LA Art Show 2024 highlights included:

- A musical performance by Korean artist Choi Sori who through drumming and manipulation of metal surfaces, Choi creates an abstract interplay of light, color, and sound.

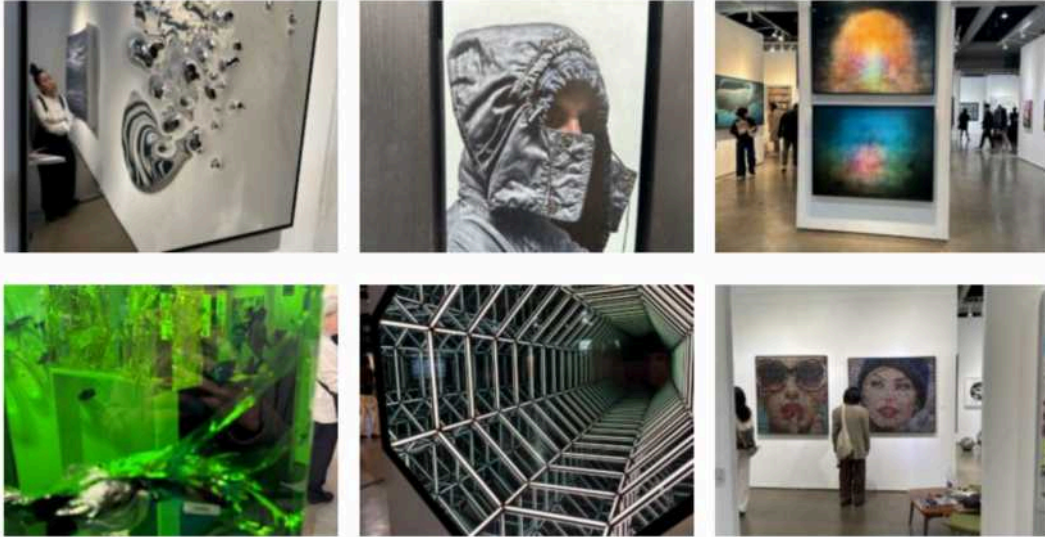

<https://www.laartshow.com/> is held at the downtown Convention Center each year in February and is one of the world's most outstanding exhibitions for hundreds of contemporary artists who have gone through a rigorous screening process. That said, if your taste is as narrow as ours, you may find only a dozen galleries that really appeal. We especially loved the emerging and outsider artists of BG Gallery in Santa Monica, which featured Ramona Otto's spectacular mixed media "Holy Cow: Prayer for Peaceful Coexistence" (see photo), Molly Gambardella's heads made of sticks, and Jack Reilly's Circles of Time. The mystical and visionary art at the Copro Gallery, also in Santa Monica, was featured Mark Garro, Chris Mars, and Sui Yumeshima. The Bruce Lurie Gallery in Pacific Palisades hosted some edgy artists, notably Isaac Pelayo's humorous play on classical paintings. We found Georgia's Kirsten Stingle's "narrative sculptures" of women to be works of talent and imagination. Chicago's Galerie Fledermaus hosted several innovative sculptors and painters, notably Alessandra Maria who created dark fantasy women. Another collection of favorites was at New York's Arcadia Contemporary, especially the fantastic tiny heads of animals and humans by Stephen Mackey and Julio Reyes' "Pegasus."
