LA Art Show 2025: 30 Years Strong, Standing with a Resilient Los Angeles

The LA Art Show stands as Los Angeles's largest and longest-running art fair, marking an extraordinary milestone with its 30th anniversary edition from February 19-23, 2025, at the Los Angeles Convention Center. As we reflect on three decades of artistic innovation and cultural exchange, we recognize the foundations that have made this evolution possible—our longtime exhibiting galleries who have been instrumental in shaping the show's legacy and will once again be part of this historic anniversary celebration.

In light of the recent challenges faced by our city, the LA Art Show reaffirms its commitment to the Los Angeles arts community. "As LA's longest-running art fair, our mission is unequivocal: to champion the artists and galleries that constitute our cultural landscape," says director and producer, Cassandra Voyagis. "This decision stemmed from a resolute commitment to aid in the healing and rebuilding efforts while offering much-needed community support and reprieve."

We believe that art has the power to heal, unite, and inspire, especially during difficult times. This year's show will not only celebrate our 30-year journey but also showcase the resilience and creativity that define Los Angeles.

Our 2025 edition promises a rich tapestry of international art, featuring galleries and artists from around the world. Following are special initiatives and highlights of what visitors can expect:

- Free entry for firefighters and their families as a thank you for their heroic efforts.
- A portion of proceeds will be donated to support rebuilding efforts.
- LA artist **Robert Vargas** will create a live mural, "Heroes," during Opening Night to honor first responders. The mural will be gifted or auctioned to benefit fire relief victims.
- **Building Bridges Art Exchange** will showcase work by artists affected by the fires, including Petra Eiko, Walter Erra, Hubert, and others, with all proceeds supporting these artists.

International presentations include:

- **DIVERSEartLA**: Our non-commercial platform, curated by Marisa Caichiolo, returns with a compelling retrospective of its eight-year journey, featuring eight famed art institutions.
- **LICHT FELD GALLERY** (Switzerland): Featuring multidisciplinary artist and poet Arch Hades' sculpture "Isle"
- **COLUMBIA ROAD GALLERY** (London, UK): Showcasing works by Kate Boxer, Thomas Gosebruch, Hannah Ludnow, and Jonathan Schofield
- **SNISARENKO GALLERY** (Ukraine): Presenting "She, Unbroken," featuring Ukrainian-born female artists
- **CORAL GALLERY** (Miami): Highlighting Roberto Vivo's sculptural works, including "The Human Tribe Totem"
- **CASTERLINE|GOODMAN GALLERY** (Aspen): Showcasing Daniel Yocum's unique approach to figurative abstract expressionism
- **ART IN DONGSAN** (South Korea): Featuring Steel Che's (Youngkwan Choi) industrial-inspired sculptures
- **DANUBIANA MUSEUM** (Slovakia): Presenting Viktor Freso's 30-foot "Bear Sculpture" in the lobby

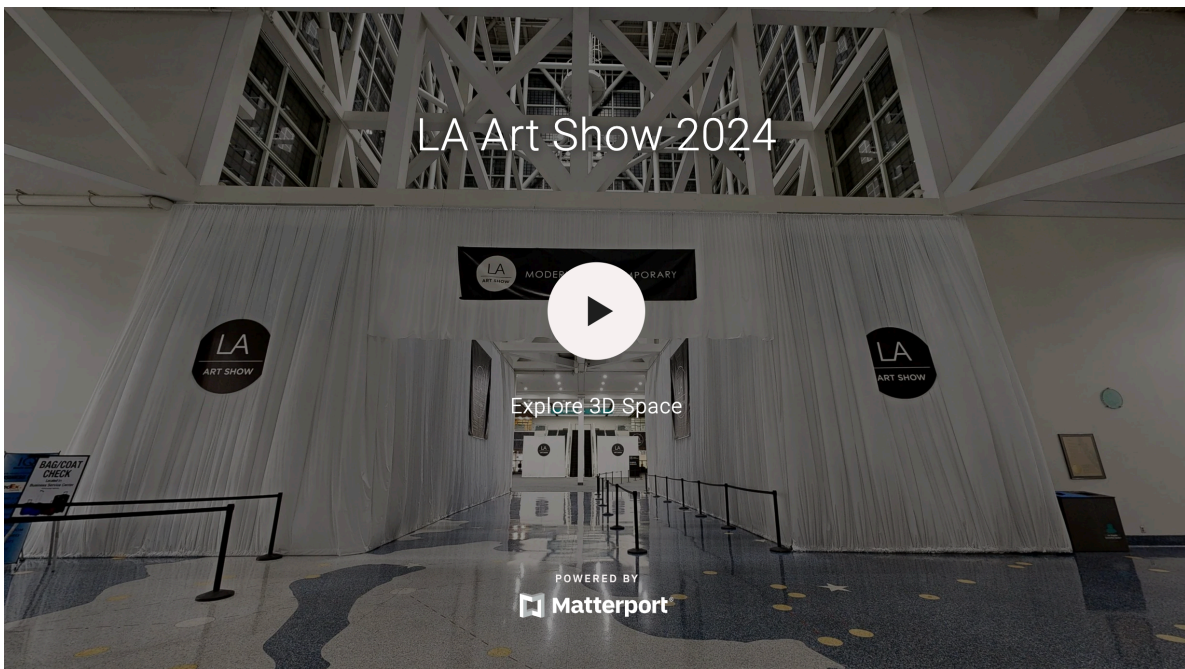

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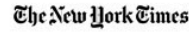
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
